

# Shurdington Parish Council

## REGISTER OF ASSETS

### Land

The council owns the following land in Shurdington, deeds for which are held by Messrs Rickerby, Solicitors, Cheltenham:

The Green, Cowlsmead (1.422 acres, registered under the Register of Village Greens maintained by the County Council)

Strip of land Blenheim Orchard/Playing Field (access)

Strip of land under Cedar Tree, Main Road

All of the above have no saleable value.

### Street Furniture

One metal & glass shelter on the main road is owned by the council, and is covered by all-risks insurance at replacement cost, as is the brick-built bus shelter opposite the Cheese Rollers Inn which is leased from Cotswold Van Centre. Three wooden glazed lockable noticeboards (Lambert Gardens, Post Office, and Hairdressers), three wooden seats, and Dog and Litter bins owned by the council are also included in the all-risks insurance with a nominal total asset value of all street furniture of £10,000.

One seat purchased March 2017; value £167.

### Office Equipment

A laptop was purchased in February 2022 at a cost of £429

### Play Equipment

Play equipment with safety surfacing was purchased in 1996, 1998 and 2009 from various funds, for installation at the King George V Playing Field. All the equipment has now been donated to the King George's Field Charity Management Committee (Minute item 111/09) which is responsible for insurance and maintenance.

A new Borneo climber and associated surfacing was installed in 2019 at a cost of £ 17,975.

A vehicle height restrictor and bollards were installed in the car park of the King George V Playing Field in 2019 to prevent unauthorised access, to the cost of £1,650.
